Acceptable Use Policy

Introduction

This Acceptable Use Policy (“Policy”) sets out the rules and guidelines governing access to and use of the PolicyCheck platform, products, services, and related tools (collectively, the “Services”).

By accessing or using the Services, you agree to comply with this Policy. If you do not agree with this Policy, you must not use the Services.

This Policy applies to all users of PolicyCheck, including brokers, advisers, firms, partners, and any authorised users acting on their behalf.

Purpose of PolicyCheck

PolicyCheck provides software tools designed to assist insurance brokers and advisers in reviewing, structuring, comparing, and managing insurance information.

PolicyCheck is:

- A technology platform and decision-support tool
- Not an insurer, underwriting agent, or adviser
- Not a provider of financial, insurance, or legal advice

All outputs generated by the platform are intended to support professional judgment, not replace it.

Permitted Use

You may use the Services only for lawful purposes and in accordance with this Policy.

Permitted uses include:

- Reviewing and structuring insurance documents
- Comparing policy terms, conditions, exclusions, and limits
- Supporting broker or adviser-led client discussions
- Internal compliance, audit, and record-keeping purposes
- Other uses explicitly enabled by the platform

You must ensure that your use of the Services complies with:

- All applicable laws and regulations
- Professional standards in your jurisdiction
- Your licensing, authorisation, and regulatory obligations

No Financial or Insurance Advice

The Services do not provide:

- Financial advice
- Insurance advice
- Legal advice
- Product recommendations
- Suitability determinations

Any references to gaps, mismatches, exclusions, or comparisons are informational only and must be interpreted by a licensed professional within their regulatory framework.
